

The Agricultural Career Show & Expo will be held in **Exhibit Hall C** on the lower level of the Raleigh Convention Center. To access Exhibit Hall C from inside the Convention Center, enter from the mezzanine level and take the escalator down into the Exhibit Hall.

Booths at the Career Show & Expo are free and include pipe and drape dividers and one table (no chairs are included).

- Tables (+\$20 each)
- Power (+\$100)
- Wired internet connection (+\$350)

Invoices for additional fees will be emailed prior to the event.


Set-Up:

All booths should be completely set up by 9:00 am on Tuesday, June 27 in preparation for the Grand Opening at 10:00 am. You may set up your booth on Monday, June 26 from 12:30 pm until 4:00 pm, or on Tuesday, June 27 from 8:00 am to 9:00 am.

If you need to unload equipment from your vehicle, you will use the loading dock to access the rear entrance of Exhibit Hall C. The entrance to the loading dock is behind the Red Hat Amphitheater on W. Lenoir Street.

A layout with booth assignments will be provided in advance so you will know where to set up when you arrive. I will also be onsite to answer questions and to assist you with finding your booth.

Teardown:

Teardown for all booths may begin immediately after the Career Show & Expo closes at 5:00 pm on Wednesday, June 28. All equipment and belongings must be cleared by 11:00 am on Thursday, June 29.

General Information:

No vendor sales are allowed during the Career Show & Expo. You may distribute giveaways and promotional items, but you may not sell anything.

Parking is not included in your Career Show & Expo registration. Paid parking is available at several nearby parking garages. Please familiarize yourself with the [Raleigh Convention Center parking options](#) and be prepared to pay to park.

If you are utilizing the loading dock, you must remove your vehicle as soon as you have unloaded. Vehicles may not be left in the loading dock area.

IMPORTANT: If you are bringing any equipment with a fuel tank inside the Exhibit Hall, fuel tanks shall have no more than 1/4 tank or five gallons of fuel, whichever is less. The City of Raleigh Fire Marshal will be inspecting all equipment, and you will be asked to remove the equipment/vehicle if your fuel levels are not in compliance.

No outside food is permitted inside the Raleigh Convention Center. There will be a concession cart located inside Exhibit Hall C with limited options available for lunch, or you may plan to eat at a nearby restaurant.
