- Due to the growth in the number of participants, chapters may only register one team or participant per event.
- Manuscripts for prepared public speakers are due at the state office by 5pm on March 3, 2023. Manuscripts may be submitted electronically by emailing them to Carmen Bracey at carmen_bracey@ncsu.edu.
- Follow the dress code outlined in the **Event Guidelines** for each event.
- Possession of a cell phone, ipod, smart watch, or other electronic device will
 result in a total team disqualification. Please review the cell phone, electronic
 device, dress code, and tobacco use policy for state level career development
 events with your students prior to the event.
- Violations of these policies will result in penalties as outlined in the current Event Guidelines.
- Participation waivers are required for this event and must be signed by a parent if the student is under the age of 18. Waivers will be collected electronically through theaet.com. Waivers should be submitted electronically prior to the event. No waiver = no participation.
