Middle Grades SAE Award Application Instructions



Middle School members will complete the Middle School SAE Award within the Proficiency Award Application. Students can access the Middle Grades SAE Award application through their AET account. To be eligible for the Middle School SAE Award, students must complete the Basic Set-Up Information, Performance Review A, Performance Review B, Performance Review C, at least one Learning Outcome & Efficiency Factors, and six pictures with descriptions.

Once they log in, they should go to their student dashboard. From there, click on the "Reports" block.



Once the "AET Reports" page is open, click on the "Degree/Application Manager" link in the "Reports" block.

When the Degree/Application Manager page opens, there is a drop-down menu of new applications. Select "National Proficiency Application" from the drop-down menu and click "Add New."
