Introduction

The Cy Vernon FFA Endowment Scholarship is awarded annually in the amount of \$500. Recipient must be an active FFA member. Preference will be to award to an incoming freshman student in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at North Carolina State University. If no incoming freshman from Bartlett Yancey High School qualifies, then the scholarship will be made available to a current NC State University student from Bartlett Yancey High School in good academic standing. Statewide applications will be considered if no incoming freshman or existing student from Bartlett Yancey High School qualifies for the scholarship. Preference will be given to students based on their FFA participation as well as their academic record.

All scholarship applications are due to the State FFA Office by 5:00 pm on April 3, 2020

All scholarships are paid directly to the educational institution by the North Carolina FFA Foundation. Verification of enrollment is required prior to payment. Scholarship amounts are subject to change based on sponsorship amounts and availability.
