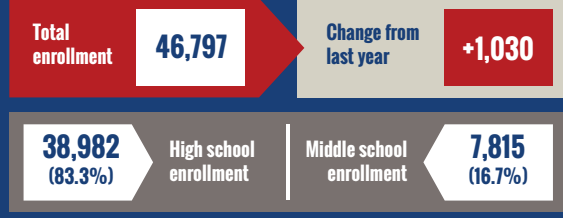

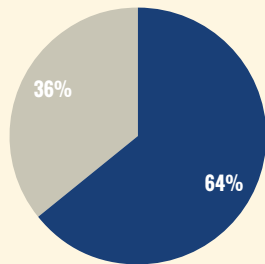

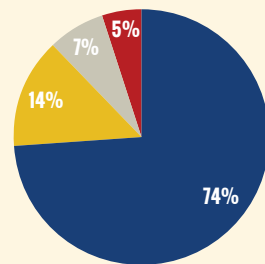


Gender of Agricultural Education Students

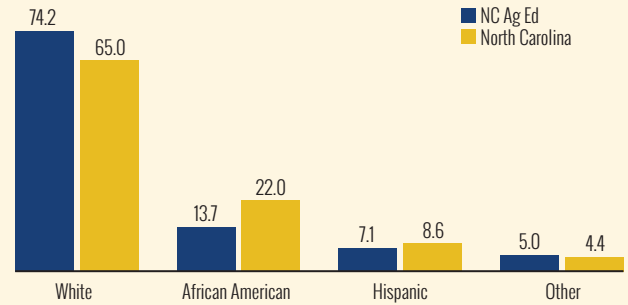
Ethnicity of Agricultural Education Students



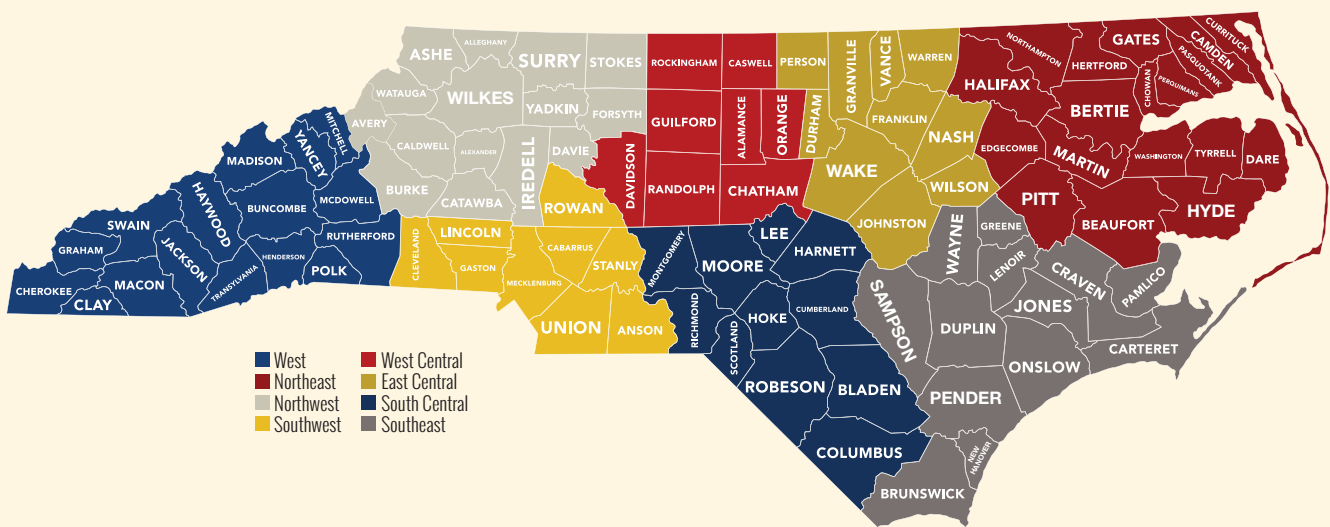

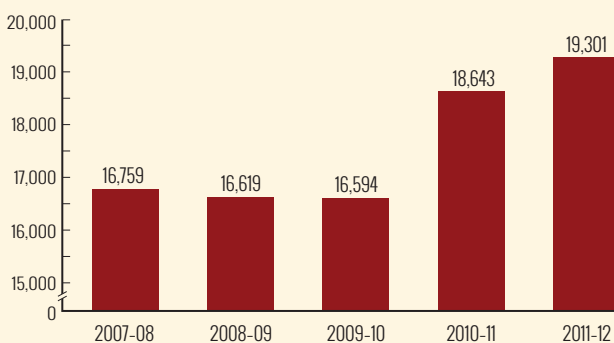

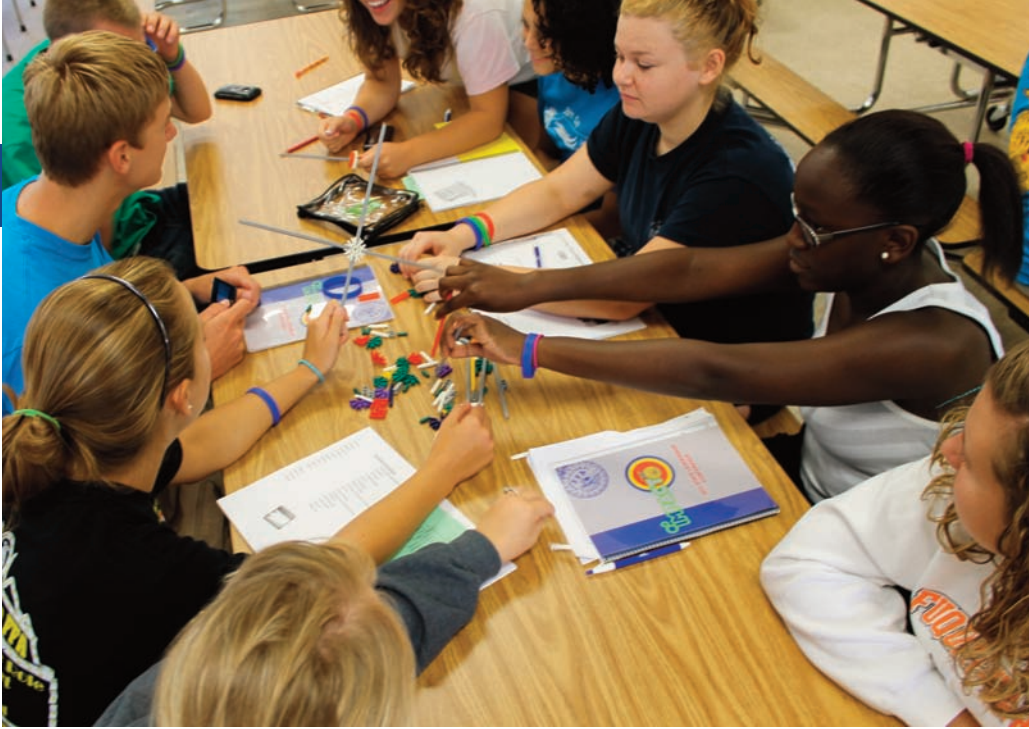

North Carolina FFA Center at White Lake

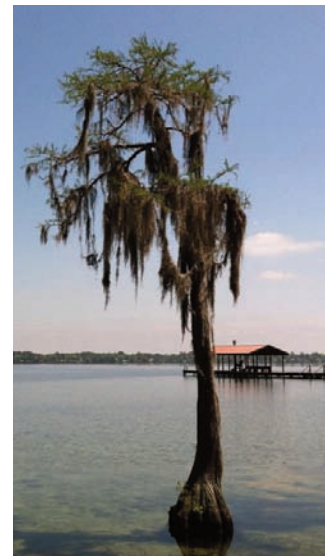

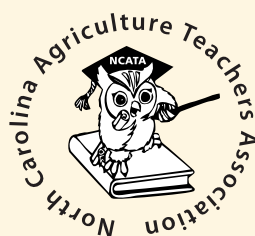
